

CHAPTER 7

KNOWN OCCUPATIONS OF SPENCER'S CHILDREN OF HIS SECOND MARRIAGE

Edgar Hubert

The only occupation that is known of Edgar (Ned), is that of his employment by Fenwick Brothers at their sawmill in Cooroy. However, it would be reasonable to assume that he had been engaged in the timber industry around the Cooroy and possibly Pomona districts.

Edgar and his family lived on the Cooroy-Pomona Road, just north of Cooroy on Portion 64 Parish of Tewantin and this is situated at the triangular corner of Pearson's Road and the Pomona Road or what is now known as Elm Street.

I have no further knowledge of Edgar and the only photo which I know of, is taken of him in Army Cadet Uniform which I presume is during the First World War. This is the photograph beside Edgar's details in the previous chapter.

Walford (Wally) Arnold Sivyer

Wally was engaged in the timber industry as a teamster.

First he had his own horse teams pulling timber to the Cooroy Sawmill. Wally and Stan cut and hauled pine from many locations in the West Cooroy, Cooroy Mountain and other areas. After the hoop pine was exhausted, Wally sold his horse team and used bullocks for hauling hardwood logs to the mills.

For some years there were two sawmills operating in Cooroy, namely Fenwick Bros and Klugston and Ireland. Wally carried on this occupation until the early 1930s when he disposed of the teams. He then went banana growing for a few years. After this he commenced dairying on the home farm.

When he sold the farm at the beginning of World War 2, he moved to Biloela where he was engaged in stud pig farming. He had been in the pig industry while farming at Tinbeerwah and was successful with many first and championship prizes at the Brisbane Royal National Show.

After leaving Biloela, he moved to Brisbane where he purchased a fish and chip shop at Alderley. He sold this and purchased a mixed business at Northgate. Wally retired from there and lived in retirement at Alderley until his death on 5 February 1967. His widow, Ruby Agnes Sivy, lived on at Alderley until 10 July 1979 when she died.

Stanley Hume Sivy

Stanley (Stan) as stated above was engaged in the timber industry also. He was a cutter for Walford and other contractors. He, Wally and Wally's brother in law, Vere Dunbar, conducted their own sawmill for some time at Tinbeerwah.

As well as this he was also a cutter of railway sleepers for many years. In fact, he combined this with small crop farming up the beginning of World War 2. Stanley joined the Armed Forces at this time but because of his age he was used as a Coast Watcher along with a lot of other male persons of that vintage. After the War he returned to small crop farming at Tinbeerwah and eventually retired to Cooroy in 1953.

However, he could not sit idle, so he took his cross cut saw and mall and wedges and returned to bush work for quite a few years. At around 79 years of age he became a diabetic and eventually this was the cause of his death in April 1969. His wife, Ellen Marie, had predeceased him in February 1967.

Percival Septimus Spurgeon Sivy

Percy, as he was always known, was also engaged in the timber industry in his early years. However, he assisted his mother on the farm at Tinbeerwah after Spencer's death.

Percy never married and he worked around the Cooroy district until his death. He enlisted for overseas service in the first World War, but the War finished while on board a boat sailing for the War Zone.

It is not known what Percy's actual employment was when he returned from the Army, but from conversations with his siblings and himself, I have gathered some information. He was for many years at home on the farm at Tinbeerwah with his mother sister, Gertie, helping with land clearing and dairying. After Wally bought the farm from his mother, I am not sure what Percy did.

However, he suffered a mental breakdown and had to be institutionalised for quite a number of years. He never returned to the home farm until the mid 1930s when he worked for Wally and at times on various other farms.

For a number of years he lived with Stanley helping him and also worked for various other people in the Cooroy, Tinbeerwah and Tewantin areas.

Percy died in Brisbane on 21 September 1961.

The story will now continue with what knowledge is known of Spencer's brothers and sisters.

CHAPTER 8

DESCENDANTS OF FREDERICK JOHN SIVYER

Frederick John Sivyer, the son of James and Harriet and brother of Spencer.

Frederick was born at Peasmarsch, Sussex, England in December 1823. He arrived in Sydney with his parents at the age of 15 years and 4 months. Nothing is known of his activities in his early years at this date.

In fact the first information that has been found is on his marriage certificate to Catherine Donovan Bathgate, sister to Elizabeth, wife of his brother, Spencer.

Frederick and Catherine were married on 22 November 1852 in the Chippendale Chapel, Sydney and according to the rites of the Wesleyan Methodist Church. According to the shipping records, he was born December 1823. This makes him just a week short of his 29th birthday when he married Catherine.

Frederick John's Death Certificate states that his marriage to Catherine Bathgate was his first marriage and that he was about 73 years of age when he married for the second time. His second wife's name was Mary Elizabeth and her surname is not known.

The only information to hand on the above children is of Frederick James and William John.

The following information on Frederick has been given to me by his descendants in north Queensland, namely, Edna Edgerton and Ruth Dodds and his son, Vic.

In 1979, I had the opportunity to talk with Frederick James' son, Frederick Victor. He was known as Vic Sivyver and in his later years resided at South Johnstone, Queensland. In fact he had a street named after him and it is known as "Sivyver Street".

In 1979, Vic was a very elderly man and died shortly after my conversation with him. He related how, in his early years, they were brick makers from New South Wales and had travelled to Ipswich, Queensland, when he was a young lad. (This would have been the family which my father, Stanley, visited when he was a lad and to which I referred to on page 8).

His family again took up brick making and this time he remembers being visited by Spencer Sivyver and some of Spencer's family. He stated that he only had one uncle and that was William. According to Vic, William went to Western Australia and never returned. He appeared to have no other knowledge of his father's family except that his grandmother's name was Catherine Bathgate.

He related how, when first arriving in north Queensland from Ipswich, they were again engaged in brick making as well as tin mining. However, his father purchased a hotel at Edmonton just south of Cairns.

Frederick James was married twice. No information has been obtained regarding the first marriage, however his second marriage was to Mary Josephine Shannley of Goulburn, New South Wales. Date of the marriage is unknown.

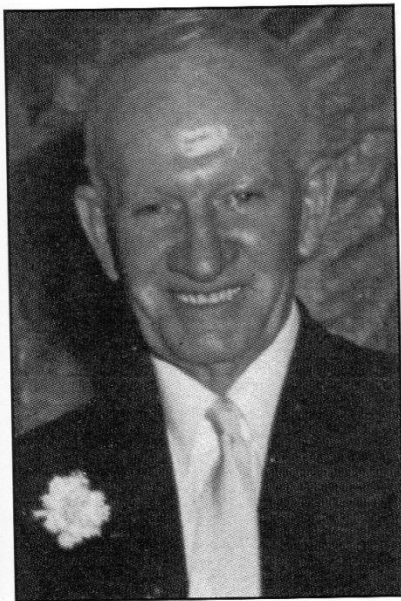

On the following pages is an article taken from a book called “Basilisk, Township of South Johnstone” by Santina Lizzio about Vic Sivyer.

VIC SIVYER BRIDGE

Before the Vic Sivyer bridge, connecting South Johnstone and Boogan, was built people wishing to cross the river drove into Hunter Street, (opposite St Rita's School), and then into Radlof Street which led to the river. The local Council would build up a section across the river with large rocks and heavy gravel during the dry season when the river was low. This of course would become impassible during the wet season as the rocks and gravel would soon be washed away by rising flood water.

Eventually a bridge was constructed around 1939, just before World War 11. It was named after Frederick Victor Sivyer, affectionately known to all as Vic.

Vic Sivyer was born in Essendon, Victoria on December 26, 1889. He was the eldest of six children. His grandparents migrated from England as free settlers on the vessel Argule in 1839. Vic's father was born in Newcastle, New South Wales in 1859.

At the very tender age of nine Vic worked in the mines in Victoria and then followed a family tradition of brick making and bricklaying at Stannary Hills near Herberton and Wright's Creek near Cairns. In 1910 he married Hannah Butcher in Cairns where their daughter Mary was born the following year. Vic and Hannah moved to South Johnstone in 1914 where their second child, Fred, was born in Innisfail the same year.

Mary and Fred Sivyer were among the first students enrolled at the South Johnstone State School. Their third child, Victor, was born in 1916 but sadly died in 1923 from diphtheria.

Vic and his brother Leon began to make bricks for the South Johnstone Mill, mainly for the construction of the chimney stack, since demolished. The brothers also made bricks for the construction of the Babinda Mill. Although Vic spent most of his life making and laying bricks, he was not a qualified bricklayer.

Denise Grech (nee Hughes) reflects:

"My grandfather was a creator. He loved working with clay and cement. He was always trying to make the perfect brick and prototypes that would be found in various locations around the yard. He left them there to cure in the sun. Unfortunately for Granddad these experiments never came to fruition. He did however manage to make two very large cement flower pots to stand at the gate entrance of the house. They are still standing there today. The original family home was built in Sivyer Street, South Johnstone but burned down. Granddad built another home on the original site."

In spite of his busy life Vic found time to play football for the South Johnstone Club and was awarded Premiership medals in 1917 and 1918; these are still in the possession of his family.

During the 1927 strike Vic was a staunch member of the Australian Labor Party and was a prominent figure in the strike action. He walked from Babinda to Tully to collect money for the strikers.

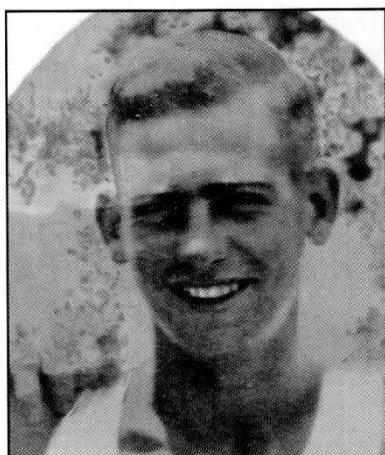
Despite not having the benefit of a full education, he was a fluent debater and an eloquent speaker. He often chaired functions particularly during the Second World War when returned servicemen were treated to welcome home parties at either the picture theatre or the library.

Vic Sivyer was a man who wore many hats. He was a Justice of the Peace, a life member of the Australian Labor Party and he was involved in the establishment and running of the South Johnstone Branch of the Queensland Ambulance. He served several terms as a Councillor of the Johnstone Shire, including terms as Deputy Chairman. For several years he was also a member of the Innisfail Hospital Board. His name is inscribed on a plaque with the original councillors of the "new" Innisfail Shire Hall building.

As chairman of the Mourilyan Harbour Development Scheme he endeavoured to interest the State Government and Local Council in developing Mourilyan Harbour as a general port, not only a sugar terminal. Vic walked many miles to collect donations for the funding of this project.

As a tribute to his long and devoted service to the South Johnstone Sugar Mill, Vic was permitted to work on very light duties long past his official retirement age. He walked to work from his home in Sivyer Street across the rail bridge over Cheeki Creek to the mill. Each day after work he would carry home in a sugar bag, ice for the home ice chest until refrigeration was installed in his residence in 1955.

On September 7, 1980, after a long bout of illness Vic Sivyer passed away in the Innisfail Hospital. Many mourners gathered to pay tribute to a great man and pioneer of the district.



The Vic Sivyer Bridge, like many other bridges, attracts people who fish or swim. On February 8, 1942, young Clive Rowe, aged twenty, was swimming with some friends near the bridge. Clive, born in 1922, was a member of the ETTY Bay Surf Life Savers' Club and therefore was an extremely strong swimmer. The river was in flood and running quite fast. Clive, looking for a better spot to swim decided to travel up stream from the bridge. He was headed to a popular swimming hole between the rail bridge and the corner behind the Department of Primary Industries.

James also had two brothers and a sister who migrated to Australia. The brothers were William and Stephen. His sister was Sarah and by this time she was married to Frederick John Goodsell.

I attended a reunion of the Goodsell Clan in 1987 in Sydney. Since then I have received information from Pat Lawther, a Goodsell descendant, concerning their history. The Goodsell were brickmakers in New South Wales and contributed greatly to the Colony in its early years. Sarah Goodsell (nee Sivyver) died on 6 September 1868.

There are also descendants of Reuben Sivyver here in Australia. Reuben migrated to Australia about the same time as the others, however, he is not a son of William and Elizabeth but it is felt that he may be a relative, because they all came from around the same area. Reuben is the fore-father of the Hunter Valley Sivyvers.

On 24 June 1989, information was received from descendants of William Sivyver, uncle of Spencer. Refer to earlier chapters containing the Immigration Listings.

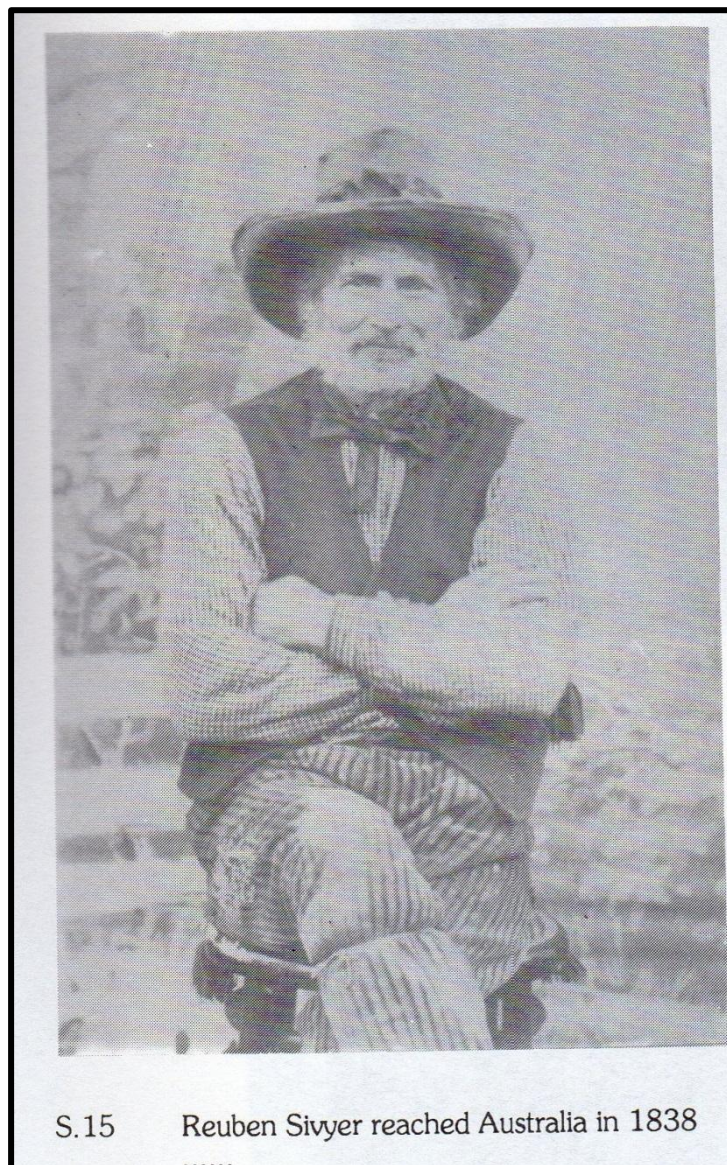

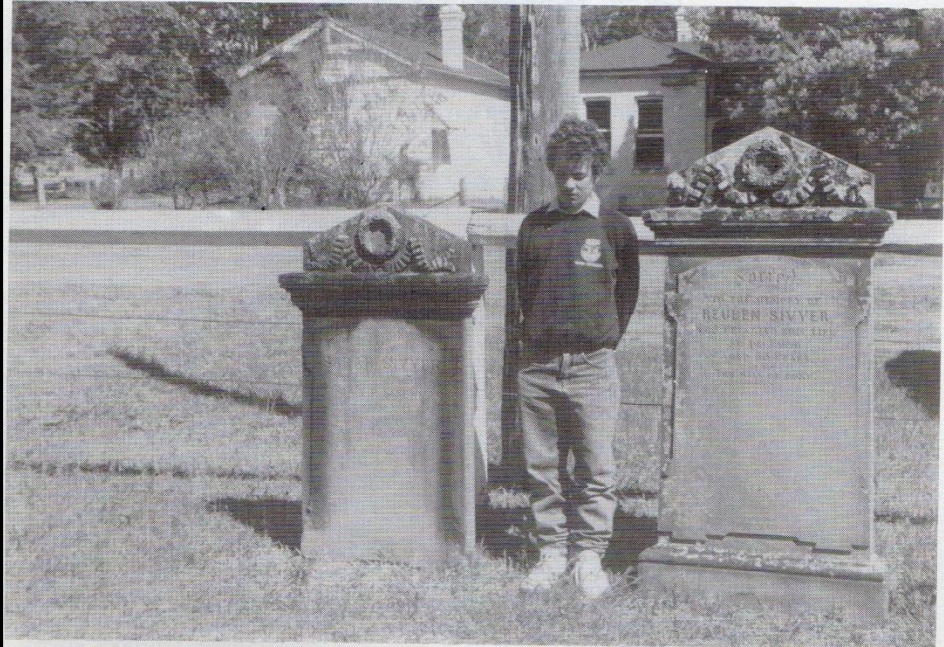

Elizabeth Sivyver was born at Peasmarsh, Sussex, England on 1 August 1823 and arrived in Sydney with her parents, James and Harriet. She was at this time approximately 16 years of age.

Elizabeth married Samuel King, a convict, who had been transported to Australia on the "James Pattinson". Samuel had been sentenced to seven years. At this time he was 17 years of age and he arrived in Australia in July 1839.

Samuel and Elizabeth were married on 5 June 1841. Samuel had been pardoned the previous year. They first set up home at Picton, New South Wales.

CONCLUSION

At this time and date, it is all the information which the writer has in his possession on the descendants of James and Harriet here in Australia.

There are other families in Australia, but they are not directly connected as descendants of James and Harriet.

The Peasmarsh County Records Office also has a James and a Thomas, being born to James and Harriet Sivyver.

These two probably died before James and Harriet migrated to Australia. Thomas's birth date is shown as 13 December 1835 and James as 18 December 1826. If their parents arrived in Australia in 1839, then these two would have been with them, however, they may have been adopted or left with relatives.

There is also a record of an Emily Sivyver being born to a James and Harriet Sivyver of East Dean near Chiches Terrace.
